- 2. Create new titles, headings, and subheadings for each section.
- 3. Develop questions from reading, pictures, or data.
- 4. Prepare graph, table, chart from the reading.
- 5. Write a poem about a key idea, term, or important person.
- 6. Make inferences from the reading.
- 7. Provide new examples or make connections to another time or place.
- 8. Create illustrations, symbols, or drawings about the reading.
- 9. Evaluate a section in the reading.
- 10.Develop "what if" statements from the reading, pictures, or data.
- 11. Relate the text to your experience or to another example.
- 12. Compose metaphors or similes.
- 13. Create an analogy.
- 14. Make a chronological depiction of major events.
- 15.Create a bubble map or Venn diagram comparing and contrasting the similarities and differences of the topic.
- 16. Copy an important quote and make your interpretation.
